**NOTIFICATION**

The Governor of Tripura is pleased to make the following regulation further to amend the Tripura Board of Joint Entrance Examination(TBJEE) Regulations, 1989 namely:-

Short Title and commencement: 1. (i) These Regulations may be called the Tripura Board of Joint Entrance (TBJEE) (Seventh Amendment) Regulations, 2011.  
(ii) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

Amendment of Regulation-2. 2. In the Tripura Board of Joint Entrance Regulations, 1989 herein after referred to as Principal Regulation.  
a) For regulation 2(g), the following regulation shall be substituted, namely :-

“(g) ‘Examination’ means such Joint Entrance examination as may be instituted by the Board for admission to Engineering, Medical, Dental, Agricultural, Veterinary and other professional Degree Courses against seats reserved for the State of Tripura including the seats of **Tripura Institute of Technology (TIT).**”

b) For regulation 2(m) of the Principal Regulation, the following Regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

“(m) ‘Officer-in-charge’ means **Principal or Head of the Institute** appointed by the Board to conduct the examination at a center”.

c) For Regulation 2(n) of the Principal Regulation, the following Regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

“(n) ‘Superintendent’ means a person appointed by the Principal/ Head of the Institute to assist the Officer-in-charge in the conduct of examination.”

Amendment of Regulation- 4. 3. In the Principal Regulations, for Regulation 4 (i)(b), the following Regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

“(i)(b) A permanent Resident of Tripura in terms of Memorandum **No.F28 (6)-REV/94(P-I) dated 30.03.06** of the Revenue Department, Govt. of Tripura which stipulates that either the candidate must have been residing in the State of Tripura continuously for not less than 10(ten) years immediately

prior to the date of making application for appearing at the Joint Entrance Examination or his/her parents must be Permanent Residents of Tripura and have been residing continuously for not less than 10(ten) years in Tripura immediately prior to making application by his/her wards for appearing at the Joint Entrance Examination”.

Amendment of Regulation-4.

4. In the Principal Regulations, for  
a) Regulation 4(iii), the following Regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

“(iii) In case a candidate is not permanent Resident of Tripura but his/her parent is an Officer on deputation to the Government of Tripura/Officer of the Central Government working in Tripura and has served in Tripura continuously for a period of **3 (three)** years or more and passed Higher Secondary Examination from an Institution of Tripura he/she is eligible for **appearing in the examination.**”

- b) For Regulation-4(iv), the following Regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

“(iv) If a candidate is allowed a seat inside or outside the State on the basis of result of Joint Entrance Examination conducted by the Tripura Board of Joint Entrance Examination he/she shall not be eligible to appear at the Joint Entrance Examination in subsequent years unless he/she has surrendered the allotted seat in writing within **7 (seven) working days from the date of selection through counseling to the appropriate authority.**”

Amendment of Regulation-5.

5. In the Principal Regulations, for Regulation 5 of the Principal Regulation, the following Regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

“**Syllabus of the Examination:** - # The syllabus of the Tripura Joint Entrance Examination, as framed by the Tripura Board of Joint Entrance Examination **will be followed** in setting questions for the said Examination.”

Amendment of Regulation-7.

6. In the Principal Regulations, for Clause 7 of the Regulation, the following Regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

“**Medium of examination:** Candidates of the examination of the Board shall have the option to answer the question papers through the medium of either English or Bengali.”

Amendment of Regulation-8.

7. In the Principal Regulations, for Regulations 8(a), the following Regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

“(a) **Mode of examination:** Candidates for the examination shall be examined by means of question paper which they will be required to answer in writing/**or by marking.**”

Amendment of Regulation-12. 8. In the Principal Regulations, for  
a) Regulation 12(ii) of the Principal Regulation, the following Regulation shall be substituted namely:-

“(ii) **Admission to the Examination Hall:** Admit Cards of all candidates should contain a **Self attested** photograph”.

Amendment of Regulation-13. 9. In the Principal Regulations, for Regulation 13(e), the following Regulation shall be substituted, namely:-

“(e) To ensure that the packets containing the written/ **marked** answer books are prepared strictly according to the Board’s instruction”.
